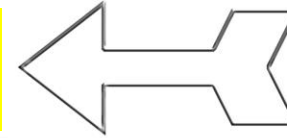
MEDICAL INFORMATION

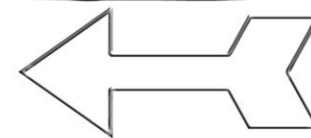
Personal Pupil Insurance
